



The verb To Be (Simple Past)

Alice <u>was</u> at the library two hours ago.



Alice <u>is</u> at the library now.

I <u>was</u> your teacher last semester/year.



I <u>am</u> your teacher this semester/year.

My friends (they) were at home yesterday.



My friends
(they) <u>are</u>
at home in
this
moment.

We use the verb to be (simple past):

To express location IN THE PAST.

Example:

I <u>was</u> in class yesterday.

She was here.

They <u>were</u> in the football field last night.

He was over there.

We were in the laboratory last week.

Personal pronouns (I, you, we, they,

he, she, it) use **WQS** or **Were**.

were (you, we, they)

was (I, he, she, it)

To describe something about yourselfor somebody else IN THE PAST.

Example:

Mary was my teacher last year.

You were my neighbor ten years ago.

Peter and I were friends in the kinder garden.

I <u>was</u> eleven years old five years ago.

He was my soccer coach in high school.

The Verb To Be IN THE PAS means in Spanish ERA/ESTABA.

The verb TO BE (simple past) structure.

Correct form of the verb TO BE (was/were)...













- Ø
- (-) NEGATIVE (not)

- I <u>was</u> (yo... era/estaba)
- You <u>were</u> (tu... eras/estabas)
- We were (nosotros/as... eramos/estabamos)
- They <u>were</u> (ellos... eran/estaban)
- He <u>was</u> (él... era/estaba)
- She <u>was</u> (ella... era/esaba)
- It was (eso, aquello... era/estaba)

- I wasn't
- You were not
- We weren't
- They were not
- He wasn't
- She was not
- It wasn't

- a) was/were = T0 BE (PAST)
- b) were not = weren't c) was not = wasn't



(s.a.) Short Answer:

- (+) Yes, I was.
- (-) No, I wasn 't.
 - *(+) Yes, I *was*.
- *(-) No, I wasn 't.
- (+) Yes, we were.
- (-) No, we weren 't.
- (+) Yes, they were.
- (-) No, they weren 't.
- (+) Yes, he was.
- (-) No, he wasn 't.
- (+) Yes, she was.
- (-) *No, she wasn't*.
- (+) Yes, it was.
- (-) No, it wasn 't.

• Was he_____...?

• Was she_______...?

EXAMPLES:

LOOK THE CORRECT FORM ..

- They were friends time ago.
- The car wasn't red.





REMEMBER...



My **sister** <u>was</u> to Brazil.

- We <u>were not</u> the champions (Broncos).
- Miss. Anderson wasn't my teacher.
- Was Michael your brother?

Yes, he was. No, he wasn't.

- They <u>weren't</u> friends, just classmates.
- Daniel was the president of my class.
- <u>Was</u> I in the school yesterday?

Yes, I was. No, I was not.

- Mary ann wasn't my grandmother, she was my aunt.
- Were you in your house last night...? (your answer)

uses TWO different forms: **WAS**, and **WERE**, you can use them in affirmative form.

The verb TO BE IN THE PAST

Use <u>was not</u>, and <u>weren't</u> in negative form.

To ask questions with...

<u>WAS</u> (I, he, she, it...) ?

and

<u>WERE</u> (you, we, they)?
