Imperative form...

LISTEN TO THE CD!!! DON'T SPEAK!!!

- We form the imperative with the <u>base form</u> of the verb.
- Write in your notebooks!!!
- Close your books!!!
- We form the negative form with <u>don't</u> + <u>base</u> <u>form</u> of the verb.
- <u>Don't</u> speak!!!
- *Don't* cry!!!

- We use the imperative form to <u>ask</u> someone to do something.
 - Talk in pairs.
- We can use <u>"please"</u> to be more polite.
- Close the door *please*.
- Look at the board *please*.




Examples... IT IS:

- REGULAR: (2:06am) two-oh six, two-zero six.
- AM-PM:11:20 am, two-twenty pm, 5:50 pm, three-twenty am.
- HRS: 09:00 hrs, 11 hrs, 15:00 hrs, 24 hrs, 0600 hrs.
- O'CLOCK: One o'clock (am), 5 o'clock (am), 8 o'clock (pm)
- HALF: (1:30pm) one-thirty = one and a half. (1/2)
- PAST: (4:12pm) twelve past four.
- TO: (5:40am) twenty **to** six.
- QUARTER: (6:15) quarter past six. (1:45) quarter to two. (1/4)

<u>Moments...</u>

At noon (12:00pm)

@ night (8:00 pm - 11:59pm)

At midnight (0:00hrs)

YEARS... (only)

in 1586, 1785, 1994, 2007, 2015, etc.



1996

<u>MONTHS...</u>

in January, May, July, December, etc.





SEASONS OF THE YEAR...

in the... Spring, Summer, Fall(Autumn), Winter.

- On Monday, Tuesday, Friday, etc.
- On (DAY) + Moment of the day (morning, afternoon, evening/night)

DATES...

- **On** March 1st, 1996.

HOLIDAYS...

- On Mothers' day, Fathers' day, Christmas' day, Columbus' day, etc.
- On the weekend/weekends...
- On weekdays
